PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Office of Secretary of the State's (SOS) critical election administration systems is at an end-of-life situation as the current vendor was bought out by another supplier who may or may not continue to support the platform. This includes the North Dakota (ND) Voices systems which interacts with all 53 counties.

In addition, replacement of the current campaign system is needed as the current software was initially built with a minimal budget and has limited functionality. The vendor who originally programmed the system no longer offers campaign finance software and North Dakota is the company's only customer. The current system has limitations for future modifications that may be needed due to potential legislative changes that may become adopted and have been discussed over the past several sessions.

BUSINESS NEEDS AND PROBLEMS

Replace the current EMS/Campaign Finance system and avoid an end-of-life situation with the current system by replacing it now.
